



Fees and Charges – Academic Year 2009-2010

UPPER SCHOOL (DAY) – Year 3 (7 and 8 year olds)	£3,946 per term
UPPER SCHOOL (DAY) – Years 4 to 8 (8 to 13 year olds)	£4,340 per term

What's included in the fees?

Day fees include text and exercise books, lunch (and tea when children remain in school for after school activities/sport).

Extras

We try to keep any extras on your bill to a minimum. As a guide, the following are the main categories of **optional** extra charges:

- Sleepovers (when day children can stay overnight in the boarding house) cost £25 per night.
- Activities – the majority of after school activities are included in the fees, but sometimes it may be necessary to charge extra if there has been a need to bring in outside expertise, or where the activity either requires materials or incurs the hire of courts, etc. The charges are kept to the bare minimum and either subsidise or cover the cost of an activity session.
- Holiday trips and excursions (prices vary).
- Insurances.
- Examinations and invigilation.
- Minibus – flexible arrangements can be made and one-way trips cost from 84p dependent on destination.
- Music lessons:

Individual lessons	£17.80 per 30 mins
Shared lessons (2 people)	£14.00 per 30 mins
Shared lessons (3 – 6 people)	£10.50 per 30 mins
- Extra Tuition. Prices available on request.
- Special events such as Arts Week (between £10 and £20).
- School photographs (from £25 for an individual photo pack to £80 for a mounted/framed official whole school photograph).

Ways of payment

For a small charge parents may settle their bills monthly using Holmwoods Termtime Collections. **From July 2009 we will be offering our own direct debit scheme.** We can also accept payment under Salary Sacrifice Schemes and we offer discounts for fees paid in advance.
