As of the 11th February 2010 the Eastbourne College Council became the governing body for Eastbourne College and St Andrew's School. Its role will be to govern both schools and its members are trustees of the Eastbourne College Charity.

Council members come from a wide range of backgrounds including business, education, the forces and the professions; give freely of their time and expertise and are all deeply committed to the continuing success and well being of Eastbourne College and St. Andrew's School as two independent schools within a single charity.

The Council has a number of clearly prescribed responsibilities which fall into two main categories:

1. Ensuring both schools meet their objectives as educational establishments and meet legal and other requirements.

In order to ensure that both schools are governed as independent schools within the single charity there are two School Committees: The Eastbourne College School Committee and the St. Andrew's School Committee. These committees report to the Full Council.

2. Ensuring, **as trustees**, that the Eastbourne College Charity is run properly as a Charity according to Charity Law and in such a way as to continue to justify its charitable status.
